说明

- 1. 定义。MBA 核心词汇是指在该类考试中使用频率最高,最重要的词汇。
- 2. 词汇量。本节所列核心词 1170 个,加上各词的同义词、英文解释及例句,本节实际上涵盖了 5000 左右的大纲词汇,是本书的核心部分。
- 3. 英文解释。以培养直接用英文思考和判断的能力为主要目的,所释义项和例句中单词所用义项无一一对应关系;释义时以基本义和引申义为主,尽量不释本义,比如动词尽量不释具体动作义而释抽象义,如 "harvest",舍 "收割"释 "收获"。
- 4. 例句。尽量采用与经济和管理相关的例句,因为英语大纲虽然取消了经济类词汇,但基于 MBA 的应用型专业硕士特点,阅读中不可避免地会有大量经济和管理的相关内容,所以选这类例句是为阅读作铺垫。
 - 5. 标记。 ❷-英文解释, 圓-同义词, ❷-典型例句。
 - 6. 索引。后附索引表用于浏览了3遍之后检测效果和查漏补缺。
